## HSK 1

## Level description

The HSK Level 1 exam assesses your ability to use everyday Chinese at Level 1 in the "Chinese Language Proficiency Scales for Speakers of Other Languages" and Level A1 in the "Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)".

Candidates who pass the HSK Level 1 exam can understand and use some very simple Chinese words and sentences to meet specific communication needs, and are able to take the next step in their Chinese studies.

## **Candidate description**

HSK Level 1 is intended for candidates who have been studying Chinese for one semester (half an academic year) with 2-3 hours of class time a week, and who have mastered 150 of the most frequently used words and related grammar points.

## **Test structure**

HSK (Level 1) has a total of 40 questions, divided into listening and reading sections. The entire exam takes about 40 minutes (including 5 minutes for candidates to fill in personal information).

HSK (Level 1) score report provides three scores: listening, reading, and total score. Achieving a full score entails earning 200 points, while a cumulative score of 120 or above qualifies as a passing mark. HSK scores are valid for two years (starting from the exam date).
